- 3. In your own words, describe the goal in your own life that Paul references in verses 12-14. With that goal in mind, specifically how will you seek to honor God in arriving at that goal? What will need to change in your life in order to focus on that goal?
- 4. As you think about the fact that our citizenship is in heaven even now while we are on Earth, how does that change your worldview? What would be the implications for the church if we lived in that specific citizenship over the citizenship of our world?
