

**Series: Why Pray?**  
***To See God's Grace Change Our Life's Path***  
**Jonah 2:1-10**

Here are some questions with Jonah 2 in mind:

1. What has God called you to do in this season of your life that might represent going to "Nineveh"? Why is it challenging for you?
  
2. Describe a time in your life when you ran away from God's calling on your life and pursued anything other than what God was calling you to do, similar to Jonah setting sail for Tarshish.
  
3. In Jonah's life, God appointed a great fish to swallow him as a means of saving his life and providing him with a second chance. What are some other creative means of God's deliverance that you see in scripture or in your own life?
  
4. What is the end goal of us suffering the consequences of sin? Why does God allow that to happen in our lives?
  
5. Jonah changes his heart and boldly declares that "salvation belongs to the Lord" in his prayer. He remembered God when he needed God most and as a result, God allowed him to live a new redeemed life. How has this manifested in your life and what have you chosen to do with the salvation that God has provided you? This is a great opportunity to share a portion of your testimony or life's calling.
  
6. Challenge: Read the rest of the book of Jonah and discuss Nineveh's reaction to Jonah's message and Jonah's distress at the end of the book.
